Venues to avoid

Some typically popular locations such as Adelaide Oval are **not preferred** – the rooms are often long and narrow (difficult to hear everyone) with little usable wall space. Some of their technology is old and poor quality projectors. Also small/narrow rooms with lack of ability for people to move around should be avoided. The Sofitel rooms do not work very well for group dynamics (small and/or long) and service experience was patchy.
